

## ORDINANCE NO. 1

### ORDINANCE OF THE SADDLE CREEK COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT REGULATING GOLF CART USAGE ON PUBLIC ROADS

It is ordained by the Board of Directors of the Saddle Creek Community Services District as follows:

#### Section 1 - **Golf Cart Usage on Public Roads**

A. The Board of Directors (the Board) of the Saddle Creek Community Services District (SCSD) finds that the public roads within the boundaries of the CSD:

1. Provide access to the Saddle Creek Golf Club (the Golf Course) and in many instances are located adjacent to or within one mile of the Golf Course.

2. The CSD is within or bounded by the Saddle Creek real estate development and is designed with wide public streets to safely permit regular vehicular traffic and also the driving of golf carts on the public streets.

B. Pursuant to the provisions of California Vehicle Code Section 21115 the Board hereby authorizes that public streets in the CSD may be used by both regular vehicular traffic and golf carts.

C. No golf cart shall be operated in such a manner as to exceed a speed limit of 15 m.p.h.

D. Golf carts operated on public streets shall be operated as far to the right edge of the street as safely possible.

E. If operated after sunset, the golf cart shall be subject to the provisions of California Vehicle Code Section 24001.5 requiring lamp-type turn signal systems, lighted headlamps, brake lights, front windshields and other necessary equipment.

Section 2 - Violation of this Ordinance is an infraction punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100.00.

Section 3 - That the Board of Directors hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance sentence by sentence, paragraph by paragraph, and section by section, and does hereby declare that any provisions on this Ordinance are severable and, if for any reason any sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 4 - Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or

portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Directors hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and such section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion may be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5 - Pursuant to Section 36937 of the Government Code of the State of California, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its final passage.

Section 6 - The Board of Directors shall cause this Ordinance to be published and posted in accordance with the requirements of Section 36933 of the Government Code of the State of California.
